

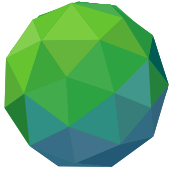

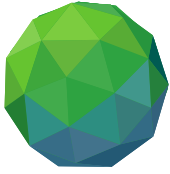

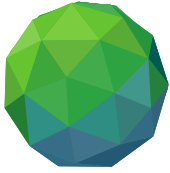

- 35 countries have formally submitted proposals, 7 have been approved / endorsed, improved proposal guidance provided

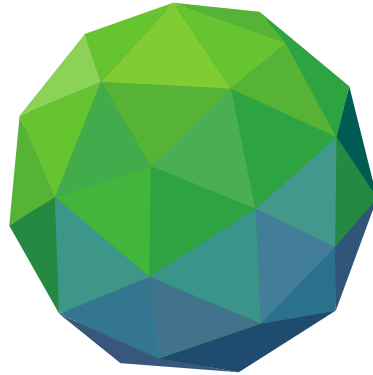

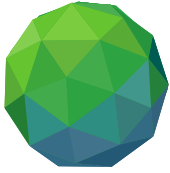

Adaptation Planning Support *Progress in 2017*

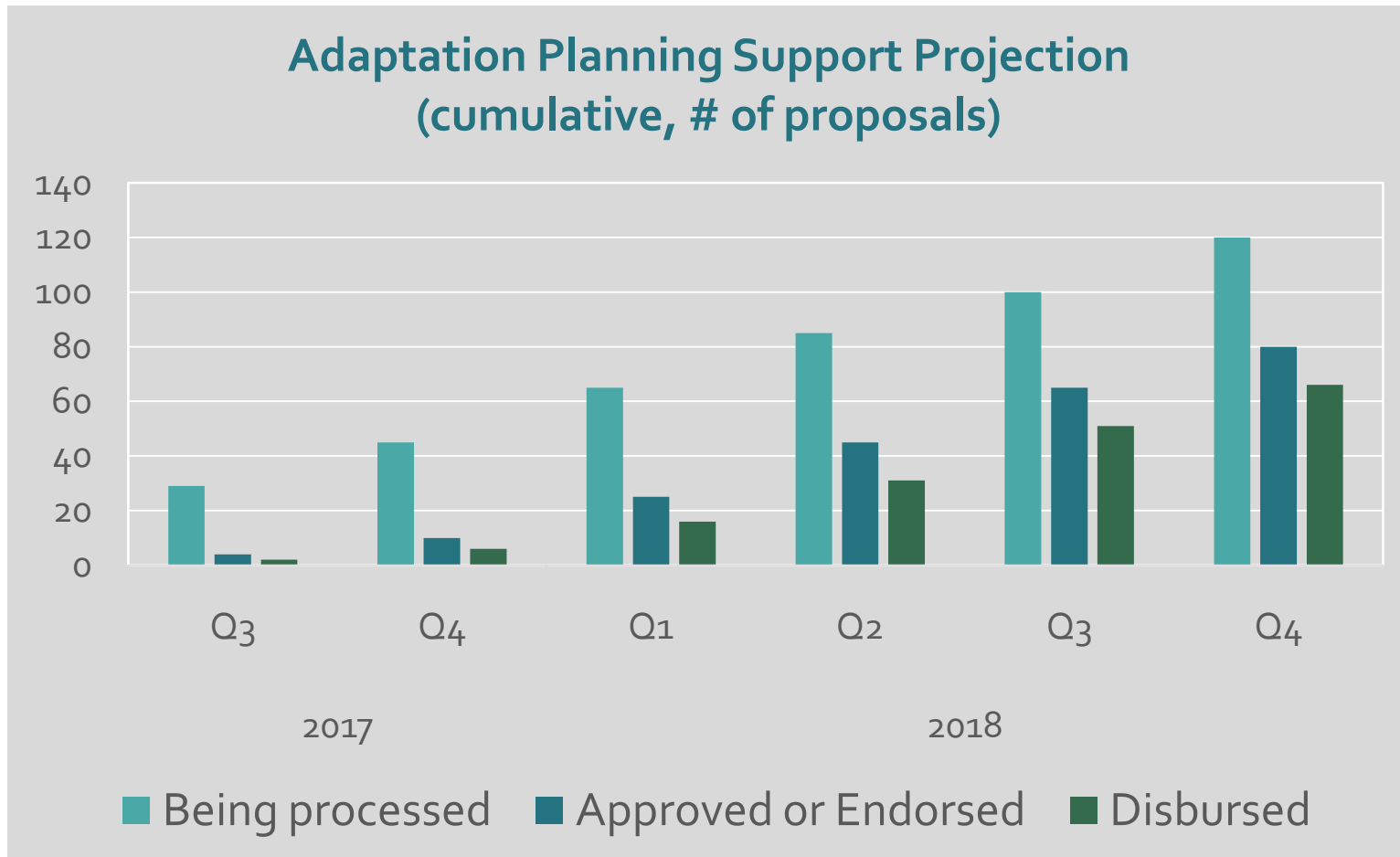
(as of 07 September 2017)

- 7 being resubmitted based on Secretariat feedback

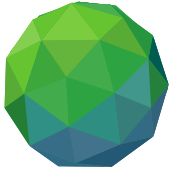




Adaptation Planning Support *Projection*

2. Choose your delivery partner carefully (relevant technical expertise, capacity to deliver in-country, etc.)

3.

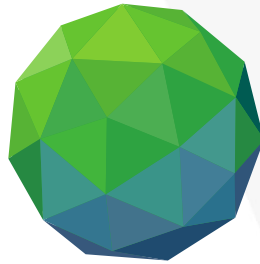
3. Plan based on specific climate impacts and context
