General observations

☐ There is positive trend in taking climate change adaptation seriously ☐ The establishment of a sound evidence base and science base has been a major trigger of scaling up adaptation efforts ☐ The centrality of human well being - national happiness, social justice, indigenous peoples, community based adaptation, human well-being, etc. ☐ Embracing of resilience as a way to characterize an adapted future ☐ A suite of integration approaches for linking the different development and climate change agenda - SDGs, Paris Agreement, Sendai, etc. are required in order to ensure effective adaptation at all levels ☐ Importance of maintaining ecosystem health



General observations

Developing funding proposals has a number of important elements such as sectoral collaboration, consideration of gender, vulnerable communities, integration with the SDGs, the national and regional frameworks, etc.
 Robust institutional arrangements, regulatory frameworks, concrete plans (national, sub-national, sectoral), funding/budget, and monitoring and evaluation systems are the high level success factors for effective adaptation
 There are a range of adaptation solutions being implemented in the region
