## General observations

---

- ❑ There is positive trend in taking climate change adaptation seriously
- ❑ The establishment of a sound evidence base and science base has been a major trigger of scaling up adaptation efforts
- ❑ The centrality of human well being - national happiness, social justice, indigenous peoples, community based adaptation, human well-being, etc.
- ❑ Embracing of resilience as a way to characterize an adapted future
- ❑ A suite of integration approaches for linking the different development and climate change agenda – SDGs, Paris Agreement, Sendai, etc. are required in order to ensure effective adaptation at all levels
- ❑ Importance of maintaining ecosystem health



## General observations

---

- ❑ Developing funding proposals has a number of important elements such as sectoral collaboration, consideration of gender, vulnerable communities, integration with the SDGs, the national and regional frameworks, etc.
- ❑ Robust institutional arrangements, regulatory frameworks, concrete plans (national, sub-national, sectoral), funding/budget, and monitoring and evaluation systems are the high level success factors for effective adaptation
- ❑ There are a range of adaptation solutions being implemented in the region that can be replicated or extended to other countries or regions -
