» The objective is to promote peer to peer support while helping participants come up with new approaches to tackle real-world problems.

Knowledge clinic: instructions

» The "patient" has up to 3 minutes to provide a detailed description of the MEL problem or challenge they face. They should be as specific as possible to get specific feedback in response.

» The "doctors" have 3 minutes to ask followup questions that are for clarification only.

» There is then 14 minutes for doctors to provide feedback on their recommendations.
