




# Regional NAP Expo & Regional UN4NAPs Forum



### **Key messages**

- 2023 marks an important year to scale up adaptation >> e.g.
   articulation of the global goal on adaptation, global stocktake
- Everyone has a critical role to play to scale up and transform adaptation to climate change >> integrated, inclusive, participatory, informed approaches; promote local expertise
- Access to multi-hazard early warning systems is among most effective means to reduce mortality and economic losses
- There is a wealth of innovative approaches countries can build on – in climate risk assessments and implementing adaptation actions




# Regional NAP Expo & Regional UN4NAPs Forum



#### **Key messages**

- Enhanced climate change risk assessment is key to decision making and accessing climate finance >> + communication
- Regional cooperation can significantly lower implementation costs, promote exchange of essential data and information, improve effectiveness of adaptation actions, enhance crossborder peer-learning and knowledge sharing in adaptation
- The updated Strategic Plan for the Green Climate Fund for 2024-2027 is set to raise ambition towards translating country priorities into climate projects and investments
- A systems approach to adaptation enhances synergy and coherence.

#### **Key messages**

- The updated Strategic Plan for the Green Climate Fund for 2020-2023 is set to raise ambition towards translating country priorities into climate projects and investments
- Strengthening the enabling environment for accessing funding for implementing adaptation is key >> role of NIEs, DAEs, NDAs; national capacity to prepare proposals, etc.;
- Decentralizing adaptation would scale up adaptation at national and subnational level;
