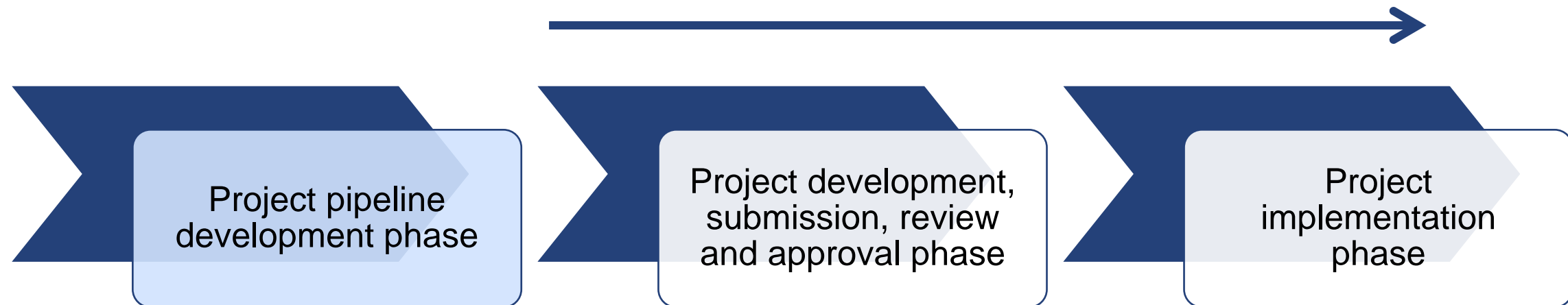

LEG monitors progress of countries these phases



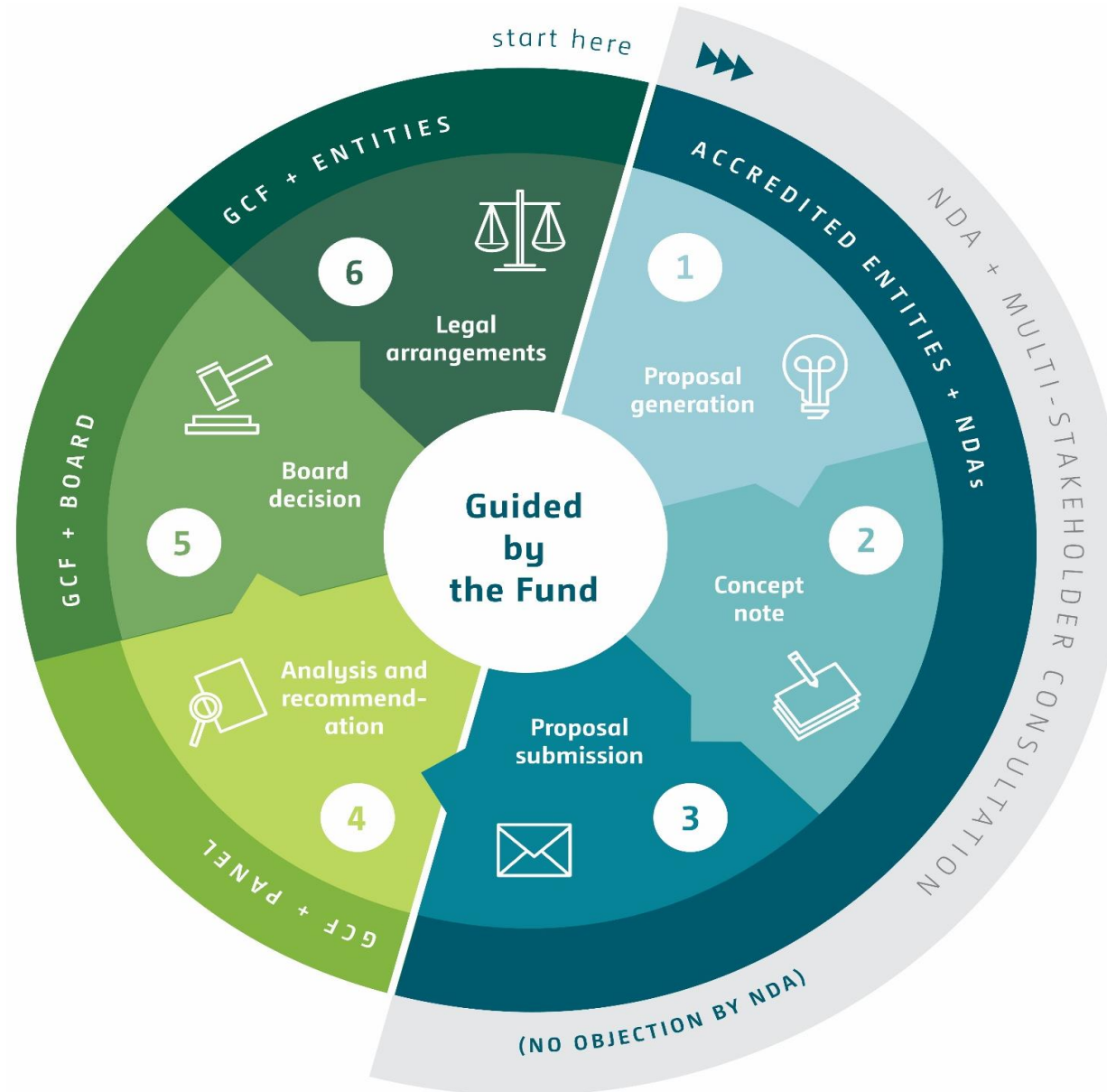
- NAP Implementation Pipeline Initiative – generating project profiles

2- concept note

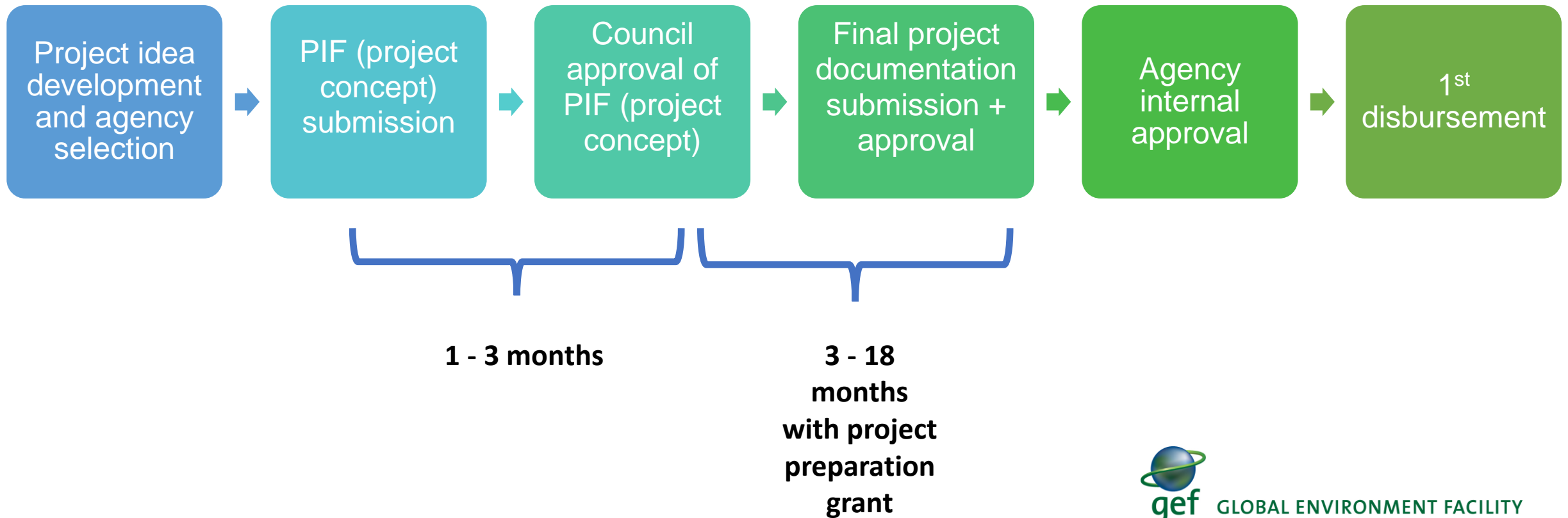
3- funding proposal submission

Cluster of countries regarding the development of project profiles

1. Countries developing new project profiles: **continue developing the project profile using the generic template for the workshop;**
2. Countries that have detailed project profile(s) but yet to confirm an Accredited Entity (GCF) or Agency (GEF-LDCF): **add any details as necessary, approach AE/Agency, update roadmap;**
3. Countries that have successfully identified/confirmed an Accredited Entity (GCF) or Agency, and ready to transition to concept note or proposal development: **work with their Accredited Entity or Agency, if present, or with the help of those present, to develop the project profile into a concept note or proposal using appropriate template of the Fund to be accessed;**
4. Countries that have successfully submitted concept notes / project proposals for funding (developed based on their project profiles) to the GCF or the LDCF **(develop new additional project ideas)**
