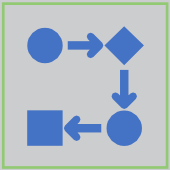

Finalization and submission to UNFCCC

NAP implementation roadmap



Communicate project idea to national stakeholders/ focal point/ authorities to generate buy-in at all levels – technical and political;



Develop a workplan/roadmap to take the idea from concept to project proposal;



Data and information collection - e.g. to create baseline, evidence base, etc.;



Identify resource requirements to further develop the concept note project:

- a. Technical team;
- b. Consultant(s);
- c. Financial resources;

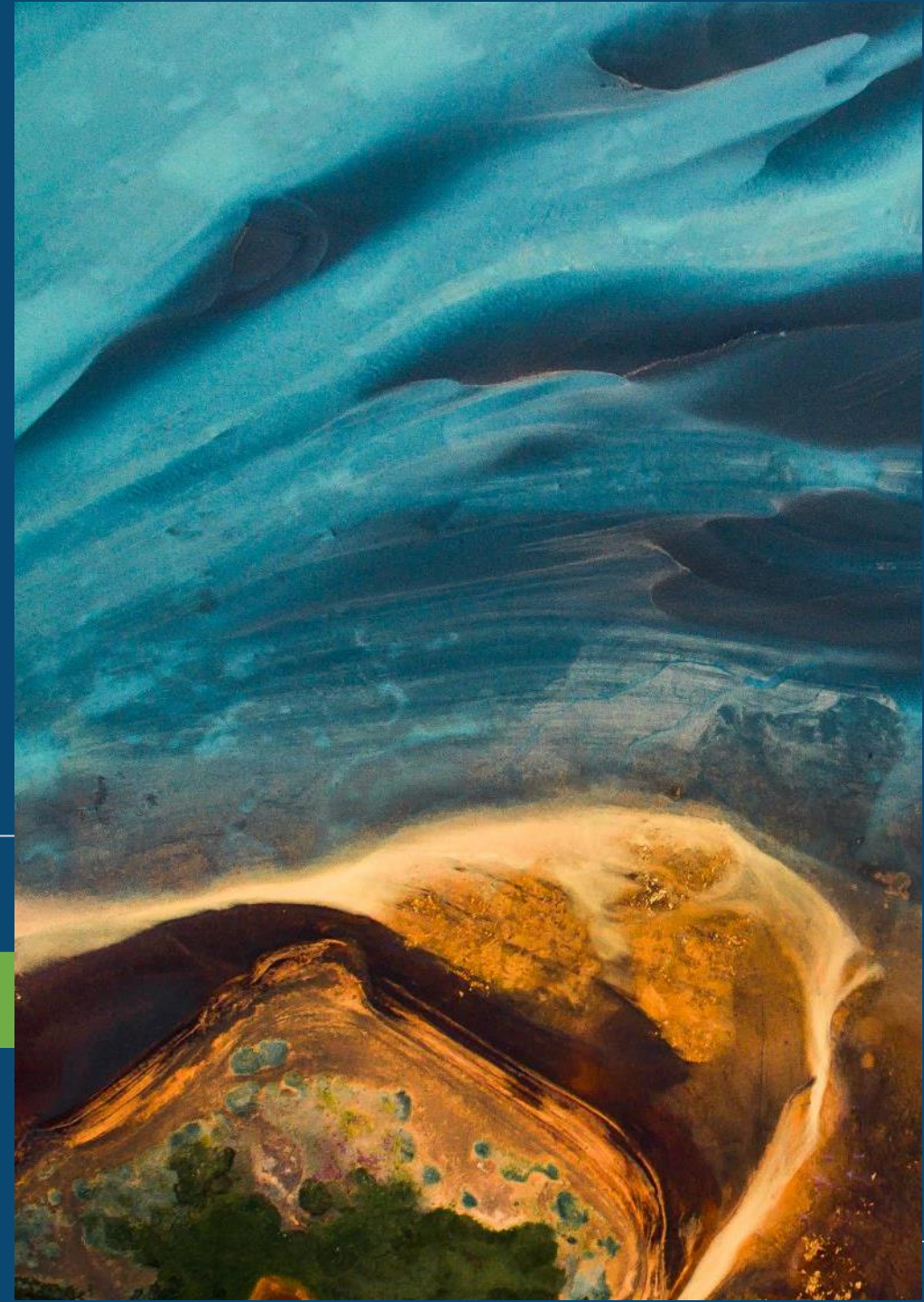

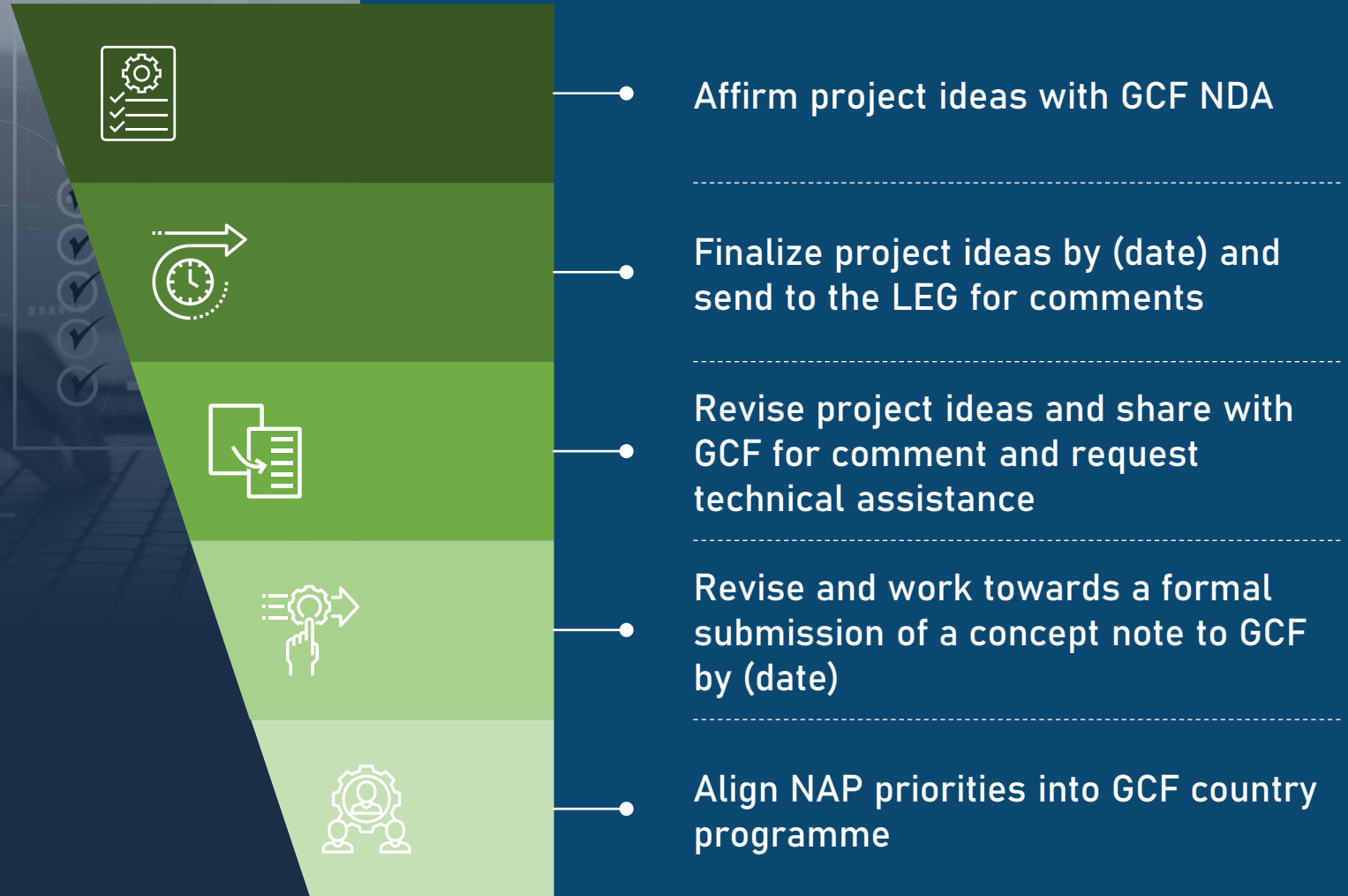
