Opportunity for demonstrating technical adaptation planning concepts and developing good practices, based on experience with real country situations




A crowdsourcing approach is used to attract specialists in different areas of adaptation planning




An open, collaborative platform for advancing national adaptation plans globally, using the best available science, inputs and experience.


Addressing delays in producing NAPs through direct country support



Offering comprehensive support to the LDCs in formulating and implementing NAPs



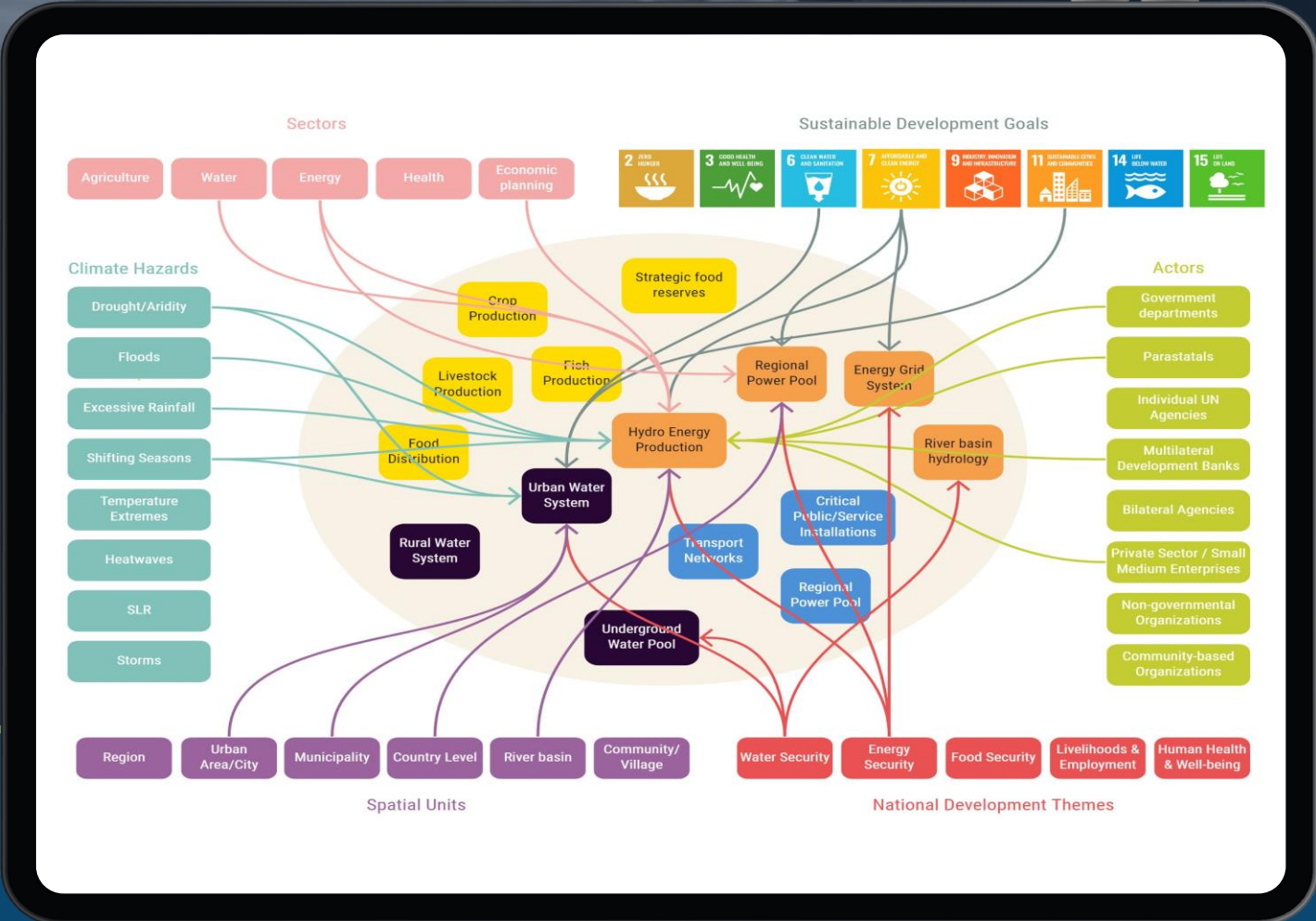
Offers an opportunity for countries to select national experts to assist in drafting their NAPs



An open process of identifying obstacles and addressing these obstacles through targeted support
